

Medicare Off Work Action Plan

Forms needed:

- Application for Enrollment in Medicare Part B (Medical Insurance)
 - Put desired Part B start date in #9 Remarks section (must be the 1st of the month)
- Request for Employment Information form filled out and signed by employer

Helpful tips:

- If you have a Health Savings Account (HSA), be sure to contact your benefits administrator **6 months** before transitioning from your work plan to Medicare. This will give you enough time to stop any contributions before Medicare coverage starts.
- Apply for Medicare Part B at least 60 days before you want coverage to begin.
- Be sure to complete **BOTH** forms to apply for Part B whether you do so online or in person.
- Make a copy of your forms and document how/when you submitted the forms.

2 ways to Enroll in Medicare:

- 1. Online: You can enroll on the Social Security website (www.ssa.gov/medicare/sign-up) by creating a secure my Social Security account. It's an easy way to enroll (if it's not time sensitive). This method may take a bit longer to process than going into a SS office in person.
- 2. **In Person:** Visit your local Social Security office to complete your enrollment. Many offices require appointments or a mail drop box out in front of the office. This is the quickest way to get approved if it's time sensitive.

Once you've received your Medicare ID, please email/text a picture of it to our office so we can enroll you in your chosen Medicare plan.
